THE JOB

- To lead the Athletics Department, managing coaching and administrative staff, ensuring that it operates effectively, efficiently and within the annual financial budget;
- To create systematic opportunities for talent to emerge through related programmes so that the development of Athletics is enhanced;
- To ensure that all scientific, medical and other athlete support services are fully utilised and integrated into the Athletics programme to enhance elite training outcomes;
- To contribute technical information to in-house and general media publications as requested;
- To contribute to the enhancement of the professional image of the HKSIL;
- To contribute towards the overall development of coach education programmes which contribute to the development of more and better local coaches; and
- To motivate and train direct reporting coaches to become high quality international coaches.
